

**TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HACKENSACK

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-07**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING
CHAPTER 108 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
SOUTH HACKENSACK ENTITLED "FEES"**

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of South Hackensack that Chapter 108 Section 3 "Fees" be amended and supplemented as follows:

Section I: Chapter 108 Section 3- Chapter 63 Recreation Commission:

- A. The recreation commission may charge a fee for admission to a township sponsored and scheduled event not to exceed \$100.
- B. The recreation commission shall charge a fee to any non-resident or non resident group submitting application for approval for use of the Veteran's Park field and/or facilities. Said fee shall be \$50.00 per day or in the event of an application for use on multiple dates the maximum fee chargeable to said non-resident or non-resident group shall be \$300.00 per calendar year.
- C. Any non-resident or non-resident group shall post with the Township cash or other acceptable form of surety in the amount of \$250.00 to be used or applied towards the costs to repair any damage or to defray the cost of labor and/or material required for cleaning of the park and or facilities. This posting shall in no way restrict the Township or Recreation Commission from requiring further or other security as authorized by Chapter 63 Section 2B of this code.
- D. For purposes of this Chapter a non-resident shall be defined as any individual who cannot produce evidence of residency by virtue of current driver's license, deed, lease, current utility bill or other acceptable evidence of residency. Any group of multiple users shall be considered non-residents for purposes of this chapter if more than fifty one percent of the group cannot produce evidence of residency as required herein.


Section II: All ordinance or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of said inconsistency.

Section III: If any portion of this ordinance is found to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction the remainder of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section IV: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.
