ORDINANCE NO. 2011-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 189 OF THE
CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HACKENSACK ENTITLED "STREET AND
SIDEWALKS"

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of South Hackensack that Chapter 189 Article II "Street and Sidewalks" be amended and supplemented as follows:

Section I: Chapter 189-4 Removal of Snow and Ice shall be amended as follows:

189-4 Removal of Snow and Ice; Prohibition Against Depositing in the Streets and Public Rights of Way

- (A) Removal of Snow and Ice- The owner or owners, tenant or tenants of lands abutting or bordering public streets, highways or rights of way within the limits of the Township shall remove all ice and snow from that impervious portion of the public street, highway or right of way lying between the property line and the curb or gutter of such public street, highway or right of way and take such other reasonable measure to ensure safe passage upon and over the same within eighteen (18) hours of daylight after the same shall be formed or the cessation of the fall thereon.
- (B) Prohibition Against Depositing in the Streets and Public Rights of Way- Any individual or entity charged with the responsibility set forth in Paragraph A hereinabove or who engages in the process of removing ice and snow from the driveway or other portions of privately owned land within the Township limits shall ensure that all such ice and snow is deposited and maintained within the boundaries of said private land and is not deposited upon the Township streets, highways or other rights of way.
- (C) Penalties- Any person or persons violating this sections shall be subject to the following fines and penalties which shall be payable through the South Hackensack Municipal Court Violations Bureau:


- 1) First Offense: \$200.00
- 2) Second Offense: \$500.00
- 3) Third Offense: \$1,500.00


Section II: All ordinance or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of said inconsistency.

Section III: If any portion of this ordinance is found to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction the remainder of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section IV: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.
