If any of the following was fully or partially **SUBMERGED UNDER WATER** due to the recent flooding, <u>you will need</u> <u>permits</u> before you make your repairs:

- 1. Electrical outlets or devices Electrical permit is required
- 2. **Water Heaters** Plumbing permit is required (with chimney verification form)
- 3. **Furnaces or Boilers** Electrical and Mechanical permits are required (with chimney verification form)
- 4. **Central A/C equipment** Electrical and Mechanical permits are required
- 5. Sheetrock & Insulation Building permit is required
