

# RESIDENTS AFFECTED BY RECENT FLOODING

If any of the following was fully or partially **SUBMERGED UNDER WATER** due to the recent flooding, you will need permits before you make your repairs:

1. **Electrical outlets or devices** – Electrical permit is required
2. **Water Heaters** – Plumbing permit is required (with chimney verification form)
3. **Furnaces or Boilers** – Electrical and Mechanical permits are required (with chimney verification form)
4. **Central A/C equipment** – Electrical and Mechanical permits are required
5. **Sheetrock & Insulation** – Building permit is required






For New Jersey residents living in Bergen, Gloucester, Hunterdon, Middlesex, Passaic, and Somerset Counties, you can apply with FEMA through the following ways:

- The fastest and easiest way to apply is by visiting [disasterassistance.gov/](https://disasterassistance.gov/) or by downloading the FEMA App on the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store.
- If it is not possible to apply online, call 800-621-3362 (TTY: 800-462-7585). The toll-free telephone lines operate from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. CDT, seven days a week. Those who use a relay service such as a videophone, InnoCaption or CapTel should update FEMA with their specific number assigned to that service.
